



PEDIATRIC POST-MASTERS CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

OBJECTIVE:

To provide qualified CRNAs and/or Graduate Nurse Anesthesia students with the opportunity to earn a post-masters certificate in pediatric anesthesia at Children's Hospital of Michigan.

PROCEDURE: Admission Requirements

1. The CRNA must have a master's degree from an accredited nurse anesthesia program and successfully passed the national certification examination.
2. The CRNA must possess a specialty licensure and have evidence of recertification when appropriate.
3. The GRNA must graduate from an accredited nurse anesthesia program and be eligible for the national examination.
4. The graduate student must be in their last semester of their curriculum for a masters in anesthesia to begin the application process for post-masters coursework.
5. The graduate student must obtain approval from their program director prior to applying to the post-master certificate program.
6. All applicants must submit a letter of interest, a copy of their nurse anesthesia transcript or curriculum content for review by the program coordinators at Children's Hospital.
7. Applicants will be expected to interview with the coordinators of the program prior to finalizing the admission process.
8. The admissions coordinator will provide the applicant with the procedure for applying to the university and the expected time to start the program.
9. Graduation and application for certification to the university will be coordinated between the university faculty and the coordinators of the program from Children's Hospital.
